

Covid-19 Directions for Cleaning and Disinfection of facilities First United Methodist Church-Monticello

Disinfectant, supplies, and equipment will be provided by the church. To arrange access to cleaning/disinfecting materials contact Administrative Assistant at church (870-367-2471, masterfumc@gmail.com)

Precautions to observe prior to cleaning/ disinfecting:

- Wear reusable or disposable gloves for routine cleaning and disinfection
- Wear face mask, skin protection and consider eye protection for potential splash hazards
- Ensure adequate ventilation
- Use no more than the amount recommended on any label
- Use water at room temperature for dilution (unless stated otherwise on the label)
- Avoid mixing chemical products
- Special considerations should be made for people with asthma and they should not be present when cleaning and disinfecting is happening as this can trigger asthma exacerbations

Cleaning/disinfecting instructions:

1. Any group meeting on the church campus is responsible for cleaning/disinfecting immediately following use of any church facility
2. Clean and disinfect commonly touched surfaces and any shared items between uses with disinfectant. Do not overlook light switches and door handles
3. Spray or pour spray products onto a cleaning cloth or paper towel instead of spraying the product directly onto the cleaning surface (if the product label allows).
4. Disinfect with only disinfectant, supplies, and equipment provided by the church.
5. Always follow the instructions on labels to ensure safe and effective use of the product
6. Use no more than the amount recommended on labels
7. Disinfectant mister should be used to sanitize large areas (FLC, sanctuary, etc) that cannot be easily cleaned by hand.
8. Any trash is to be placed in a plastic bag, sealed, and disposed of in the large outdoor trash bin on the east side of the Family Life Center.
